The doors of the church open 10-15 minutes before the beginning of Mass; please do come early, especially if you are a family group. Even though many people have now been vaccinated, we still need to wear masks and observe social distancing. Congregational singing, Communion on the tongue and distribution of the Precious Blood are all currently suspended due to the hygienic risk. The toilets remain closed. All these restrictions are likely to continue for the foreseeable future.

New Confession Times From this Saturday confessions will be heard in the morning from 10.30am to 11am rather than in the afternoon from 4pm. Whenever possible, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed. The church will now open on Saturday evening at around 4.45pm.
