Our church building is sadly **closed for public services and private prayer** until further notice. Please remember:

- Masses will be celebrated privately as on the schedule opposite; they can be watched on our Facebook page (@Uxbridge Catholic Parish) or via www.catholicchurchuxbridge.org.uk
- **every day at 12 noon** we ask parishioners to pause and pray in an act of spiritual solidarity perhaps a Hail Mary, the Rosary or Angelus. Why not, also, make a prayer corner at home?
- following the official guidelines **baptisms and weddings** are to be deferred until a later date. Any **funerals** will be celebrated at the graveside or crematorium only, with a Mass being celebrated at a later date, if requested.
- **Pastoral visits** cannot be made to those who are self-isolating but we can still communicate through phone or email!
- Remember, our parish is <u>not</u> closed. We encourage you to contact us by email or phone.
- items for the **Foodbank** can still be left at the presbytery door (if you are passing).
- **let us look after each other**, especially the elderly and vulnerable, and keep in touch with each other. Do please let the parish office know if we can help or if you have any concerns; or indeed if you would like to help in any way.
- the parish welcomes **offerings** in the absence of the usual Sunday collection—you can (1) contact us to set up a Standing Order or set it up yourself through online banking (payee details: 41308696 40-05-20 WRCDT); (2) donate to our parish via the parish page on the diocesan website www.rcdow.org.uk/ uxbridge/; (3) place money in an envelope and post it/put it through the presbytery letterbox (but only if you are passing). These are tough and uncertain times for all of us financially; thank you to all those who have already been generous.
