Current COVID Restrictions: Seats no longer need to be booked in advance, so just turn up to Mass. We still need to take down your details on arrival or ask you to use Track and Trace. We will still sanitise your hands on arrival and clean the church after each service. Some pews on the sacristy side of the church (at the front) will continue to follow social distancing. We ask that masks to be worn inside the church, for everyone's safety. Please follow the instructions for the Communion procession. Holy Communion will continue be distributed under one form and, for hygienic reasons, on the hand. The toilets remain closed.

Today is Remembrance Sunday. The 11am Mass is moved to 11.30am to allow us to gather at the Peace Memorial at the bottom of Windsor St for the Act of Remembrance.

This afternoon (Sunday 14th) at 3.10pm there is a one-off showing of a new Christian film at the Uxbridge Odeon, *C.S.Lewis: The Most Reluctant Convert*. If you wish to go, it might be best to check whether you need to book seats in advance.

The Month of Remembrance As we remember the faithful departed in November, please make sure you have filled in a sheet for the Book of Remembrance, with the names of loved ones. The repository in the church porch has some November items, including candles for home or graveside.

Advance notice that there will be no Masses between Tuesday 23rd and Friday 26th November and the parish office will be closed that week.

Most of our services are livestreamed on our YouTube channel (Uxbridge Parish). If you sit in the front two pews by the Sacred Heart or come up for Communion, you may appear on it: please let us know if you have any questions.

The Synod Pope Francis has launched a worldwide 'synodal' process, inviting us all to listen to each other and discern what God is saying to the Church. The process starts at the parish level. We want to hear from everyone who is willing to be involved, including those who do not feel 'connected' to the Church or who have drifted away. On Saturday 27th November at 6pm there will be a meeting in the parish hall for all those wanting to be part of this process. There will also be opportunities for online, telephone and 1:1 meetings, and written submissions. Please do consider getting involved and have a think about family and friends who could also be involved, including those on the 'peripheries.' Our feedback is due to be sent to the diocese by 17th December and eventually forms part of the discussions at the Synod of Bishops in 2023.
